

* MHAS-BHSupport@mha.ohio.gov:

- Request to add methadone administration/dispensing and/or buprenorphine based medication administration/dispensing, and the other associated services/medications. **NOTE: Existing methadone administration/dispensing programs will need to follow this process to add the buprenorphine based medication administration/dispensing service coding.**
- Attach the appropriate certification: either OhioMHAS methadone license and/or SAMHSA OTP certificate.
- Contact name and phone number for any follow-up.

Testing OTP Codes for 1-1-17

**** No additional claim requirements other than new codes are added**

- OTP codes will be moved to production early December
- ODM system testing – currently underway
- UAT testing follows this
- No testing can be done in cert/testing environment before December 12th

Question: How to Bill for 14 Day Supply

Monday, Week 1

- Patient presents for approved two week supply of take home buprenorphine or methadone
- Provider bills:
 - H0020 TV for week 1 administration of methadone
 - OR-
 - T1502 TV for week 1 administration of buprenorphine

Monday, Week 2 (separate claim)

- OTP bills for the second week of medication dispensed the week prior
- Provider bills:
 - H0020 TV for week 2 administration of methadone
 - OR-
 - T1502 TV for week 2 administration of buprenorphine

Trading Partner Information & File Testing



** This work will not affect 1-1 or 7-1 implementation of BH Redesign



- EDI services are being transitioned from the Ohio Department of Administrative Services (DAS) to Hewlett Packard Enterprise (HPE)
- June 2016: Trading partner testing began for the new system
- Transition moving slower than expected – technical hitches are being identified and resolved
- Trading partners will be contacted once ready for testing
- ~~BH trading partners who have not been contacted with transition information should ensure MITS contact information is accurate or contact DAS.EDI.Support@das.ohio.gov as soon as possible~~
