### **\*\*\* Specialized Recovery Services Provider Toolkit Available**

Ohio Medicaid and OhioMHAS are pleased to announce the release of a [Provider Toolkit](#) to help you prepare for the new [Specialized Recovery Services \(SRS\) program](#). The toolkit includes an agency checklist, information about services offered through SRS, eligibility requirements, billing codes and rates, guidance on enrolling individuals and more. The SRS program was designed to help individuals with serious and persistent mental illness, who currently spend down their income to be Medicaid-eligible, keep their coverage. In addition to full Medicaid coverage, individuals will have access to three new services: recovery management, Individualized Placement and Support – Supported Employment (IPS-SE) and peer recovery support. More information on covered services under the SRS program can be found in Ohio Administrative Code Rule [5160-43-04](#).
