

Third-Party Liability (TPL) Resource Documents

OVERVIEW

This MITS Bits is specific to community behavioral health centers (CBHCs) – providers types 84 and/or 95 only.

Over the last several months, the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) and the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (OhioMHAS) have collaborated with CBHC representatives and the Medicaid managed care plans (MCPs) on the existing TPL process.

As part of an effort to improve the overall process, the departments have developed two TPL resource documents to provide CBHCs with more helpful information.
