





Number and Age-Adjusted Rate of Unintentional Drug Overdose Deaths by Year, Ohio, 2010-2020*




Number of Unintentional Drug Overdose Deaths by Quarter, Ohio, 2017-2020*



Number of Unintentional Drug Overdose Deaths by Month, Ohio, 2017-2020*




Number of Unintentional Drug Overdose Deaths and Suspected Drug Overdose ED Visits by Month, Ohio, 2017-2020*






Age-Adjusted Rate of Unintentional Drug Overdose Deaths by Sex, Ohio, 2014-2019




Rate of Unintentional Drug Overdose Deaths by Age, Ohio, 2014-2019




Age-Adjusted Rate of Unintentional Drug Overdose Deaths by Race/Ethnicity, Ohio, 2014-2019




Age-Adjusted Rate of Unintentional Drug Overdose Deaths by Sex and Race/Ethnicity, Ohio, 2014-2019




Rate of Unintentional Drug Overdose Deaths by Age, Sex, and Race/Ethnicity, Ohio, 2019



Percentage of Unintentional Drug Overdose Deaths Involving Select Drugs by Sex and Race/Ethnicity, Ohio, 2019




Percentage of Unintentional Drug Overdose Deaths Involving Select Drug Combinations by Sex and Race/Ethnicity, Ohio, 2019





Number of Unintentional Drug Overdose Deaths Involving Select Drugs, Ohio, 2014-2020*


















Medicaid MAT Providers Billing SFY























Billing in SFY 2018 & Not in SFY 2020




Medicaid Early Intervention Providers
Billing in SFY 2020 & Not in SFY 2018





























2018 & Not in SFY 2020















































Utilization Management Targeted Workgroup Update

- SUD Prior Authorization Pilot kicked off on 3/1/21 and concludes on 4/30/21
- 2/16 Targeted Workgroup meeting team solicited input/feedback on SUD Residential Treatment FAQ document
- Next steps:
 - » State team to research how other states are implementing PA processes and bring concepts back to the TW
 - » State team to present additional data analysis based on feedback from past meetings
 - » Evaluate the Pilot form at the conclusion of the Pilot process and determine next steps for operationalizing

Opportunity for Behavioral Health Agencies to Apply for Expanded HIE Services

- ODM, in partnership with OhioMHAS, has obtained tentative approval for time-sensitive federal funding to expand the utilization of Health Information Exchange (HIE) services and functions among Ohio's behavioral health provider network
- This opportunity is focused on supporting behavioral and physical health integration through care coordination and data exchange
- This technical assistance opportunity is limited to interested providers enrolled with Ohio Medicaid to render BOTH mental health and substance use disorder treatment to Medicaid beneficiaries
- Agencies interested in being considered for future participation or inclusion must complete the required "Agency Interest Survey" by April 9th
- An info session on this funding opportunity will be held on April 5th via Microsoft Teams from 3:30 PM – 4:30 PM
